Thank you for your interest in the Mount Agamenticus Lodge and the surrounding summit area.

The York Parks and Recreation Department has made a decision to discontinue large group functions at the Mount Agamenticus Lodge commencing in 2008. This includes weddings, reunions, evening celebrations and any large groups of 35 or more.

The updated Mt "A" Lodge facility will house a type of educational center that will be open to the public and school groups. The facility will feature information supporting the conservation program's mission which is to protect the regions unique natural resources while providing public access for sustainable recreation activities. Interpretive displays will focus on the history and ecology of the area and offer tips on how visitors can visit with minimal impact and get involved with the many different stewardship opportunities offered here. The Mount "A" lodge will continue to be available for small educational and non-profit group meetings and programs.

Effective 2008 a Group Registration form will be required for all groups visiting the summit area, lodge, and/or nearby trails. We will continue to book small groups in the Mt "A" lodge and in a designated outdoor area.

Costs for use of this area will be \$125.00. This revenue will be applied to the Mt "A" Conservation Program and to YPRD's youth activities.

Robin Stanley will continue to coordinate the conservation effort on Mt Agamenticus and continue to work with the YPRD to ensure a pleasant and enjoyable visit.
